**Recipe for the month:** Malt Bread "Tea-time favorite"

8oz self raising flour

1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

3 oz chopped dates or sultanas

1 oz demerara sugar (available at the BP)

2 tbsp malt

2 tbsp golden syrup (available at the BP)

¼ pt milk

1 egg

Sift flour and soda, add fruit and sugar. Heat malt, syrup and milk in small saucepan; add to dry ingredients with the beaten egg. Mix well, put into a greased loaf tin. Oven 400F for 40-45 mins. Serve sliced with butter.
